





STEVE SYMONS NEW ORIENTAL GUIDE

Steve Symons was born and raised on a farm outside of Langdon, North Dakota. He graduated with honors from both Langdon Area High School and North Dakota Sate University. He married his wife Libby in 2007 at a picturesque outdoor ceremony on the Mississippi River in St. Paul, Mn (her home town). They have two beautiful little ones – daughter Georgia who is 1 and a ½ years old and little son Roland who is 2 months old.

Upon receiving his degree in Mass Communications and minor in Political Science from NDSU, Steve took a business development job with a consulting company hired by Microsoft in Fargo. After a few years, and a short stint on a failed gubernatorial campaign, Steve and Libby moved to Grand Forks, bought their first home and settled down. He is now the Manager of the IT Department at Rydell Auto Center and she is a Software Developer for Cartiva Development Group also in Grand Forks.

At the age of 21, Steve was diagnosed with Osteoscarcoma, a rare form of bone cancer. The tumor was located in his left femur. Steve is now cancer free. It took an extreme, year long chemo regimen, an amputation and multiple other operations. He uses a prosthetic leg called the 'Genium' made by a company named Otto Bock. Even though Steve was already a Shriner, he was too old to receive any help from the Shrine Hospitals, but the cause is extremely near to both Steve and Lib's hearts. They run a website called 'www.gosteve.org'.

Steve was interested in Masonry and Shrinedom from a young age. His dad, Glen, was very active in the Blue Lodge, Shrine, York and Scottish Rites. Glen, who was honored with the 33* from the Scottish Rite, died in 2015 after a long and courageous battle with cancer. He is missed every single day. Glen died 2 days before Steve was installed Master of Lebanon Lodge. The last time he attended Lodge, Lebanon was voting officers and he was able to vote for Steve for Master. He said it was a greater Masonic moment than receiving his 33rd. Steve's favorite part of being a Mason and Shriner was spending those special times with his Dad, his Mom Carla and his wife Lib. He feels lucky that he continues to have those special times with Lib and his Mom.

Steve was raised a Master Mason in Lebanon Lodge #34 two weeks after his 18th birthday in 2001 and was Master in 2015 (he feels that being Master of your Lodge is the highest honor in Masonry). He joined Kem in January 2002. He is a member of the 49ers, Ritual Divan and Fourth Floor Club. He is also a member of Malta #131, International Peace Garden Lodge, Yellowstone Historic Lodge, the Scottish and York Rites.
