Courtesy candidates' home lodge representative must bring all candidate degree work regalia, proof of election and paid status, and all degree proficiencies for their candidates. Courtesy candidates without proper documentation will not be admitted.

Courtesy work for candidates whose home Lodge is outside of the North Dakota jurisdiction must have the proper approvals from the Grand Lodge of North Dakota and the Grand Lodge of their jurisdiction.

Candidates, and brothers who are being passed or raised, need to be at the lower level of the

Grand Forks Masonic Center one hour prior to the scheduled start of the degree.
