2014 MSA

The 2014 Midwest Shrine Association (MSA) will be in Sioux Falls, SD from August 21st through the 23rd. Registration for the event can be done on line. You can go to http://www.elriad.org/MSA Registration.html to register or to get more information. The registration fee is \$65 for Nobles and \$65 for Ladies. Registration fees need to be paid by July 21st to the MSA.

There will be 2 parades at the MSA. The first one is on Thursday in Tea, SD. Line-up is at 4:00 pm, the parade step-off is at 6:00 pm. The second parade is on Saturday in Brandon, SD. Line-up is at 9:00 am and the step-off is at 10:00 am.

KEM Shrine has a block of rooms reserved at the Holiday Inn – City Centre in downtown Sioux Falls. This hotel was recently remodeled and updated. 
