SECTION 325.11 OF THE IMPERIAL CODE:

- (A)The printing, publication, circulation or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets or other devices by a Noble, suggesting, recommending, opposing. Or containing the names of proposed candidates for the office in the Shrine is prohibited.
- (B) For any violation of (a), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of officers' void and order a new election.
- (C) At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election the Shrine Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.



BOARD OF GOVERNERS UPDATE

reetings from the TC Board of Governors. As you are all aware, Covid-19 has raised havoc with not only our normal lives but has an impact on the TC Shriners Children's clinic. Our clinic patient visits are down, but telehealth visits seem to pick up the slack. We do have some good, as we have seen 4 new ND providers do first-time referrals to TC. So, my question to you, 'Are your local Doctors or other Health Care Professionals aware of who we are and our move to Woodbury?" If not, please reach out to Dana at 612-596-6104 or Sarah at 612-596-6204 in the Twin Cities to obtain information to give to them.

Our 2021 operating budget of \$8.9 million has been submitted to Tampa for review and subsequent approval. The budget includes a combination of clinic and telehealth visits, adjusted decrease of number of employees, and lease payments since we no longer own the facility.

We have agreements in place with Boys Town in Omaha and Blank Children's in Des Moines to allow us to treat more kids in more places. Outreach clinics have been put on hold due to Covid-19.

We continue to promote giving \$20 per month to the TC Clinic. If you have not, please consider doing so. It is sacrificing one meal and a couple beverages at an eating establishment per month. To establish the recurring monthly donation, please go to LoveShriners.org and follow instructions provided. Please note there will be a dropbox showing options for your location choice. Please choose Twin Cities. The first annual "Tee for Kids" golf tourney was a mild success. Next year has already been scheduled in the month of September. The Gala, which has been postponed twice, is now scheduled for June 2021.

Clothing with the new Shriners Children's Logo will be rolling out in the next month, so please be watching for this. Maybe Santa can bring you apparel with the new logo!

We have TENTATIVELY scheduled a Hospital Rep/Divan Day event in April 2021, Provided Covid 19 is under control.

Thank you for allowing me to serve the KEM temple.
