BOG Report - Roger Baier

Greetings from the Shriners Clinic Twin Cities. I hope your summer is going well.

As the pandemic slows down, we are finding the Clinic slowly getting back to pre-pandemic numbers. In June, we had 349 clinic visits, the most this year to date. We continue to show positive survey results with 96% saying they would recommend the clinic to others. The one negative is our “wait-times”, and we are working hard to correct this.

A major change to the admission process was the revamping of the Patient Authorization Form. The question the parents did not fully understand was, “Do you want to receive correspondence from the Temple?”, so they would check “No”. We have changed that line to include i.e.: Christmas parties, camps, picnics, in hopes we get more “Yes” responses to help with increasing patient participation at Shrine center events.

This year’s Gala was one of the most successful that has been held, netting \$283,000. This year’s gala also had the most attendees and the most temples represented.

As we promote “more kids in more places”, we are continuing to work with Blank Hospital in Des Moines, and Boys Town in Omaha, who allow us to see patients in these locations. We continue to have outreach clinics in Rapid City and Bismarck. As for Bismarck, in June we saw 24 patients. If you know of any Shrine patients in your area, remind them they have Bismarck as an option for appointments. This would save on driving time.

Dr. Priola recently resigned and moved out of the area. We are now actively recruiting another surgeon. In the meantime, Des Moines surgeons are assisting the Twin Cities Clinic with some provider coverage. I am optimistic we will have a new surgeon soon.

The Midwest Market Project continues to evolve as we consolidate services such as credentialing and human resources, with Chicago and St. Louis. More services are being reviewed for consolidation, and I hope in the next newsletter to have more on this project.

On September 16, Disney, ABC, and Shriners had a TV special entitled “Miracles, Magic, and Milestones” to tell the story of Shriner children in numerous entertaining ways. I hope you had a chance to see this fantastic program.

Fifteen former patients have established a Patient Alumni Network with the purpose of being mentors to current patients. I expect this network to grow, so if you know of any former patients who might be interested, please have them reach out to Sarah in the Twin Cities Clinic.

In October, our annual campaign “31 Days to Amaze” kicks off where we unite businesses and communities in support of the mission of Shriners Children. If you know of a business that would be a great partner, please contact Jennifer Sutch at Twin Cities Shrine Clinic.

In 2023, in order to stay market-competitive and serve more children, we will be focusing on efforts to continue building a model of care,

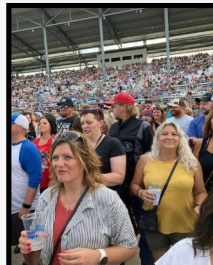

Richard Bernard "**Red**" **Skelton** (July 18, 1913 – September 17, 1997) was an American entertainer. He was best known for his national radio and television acts between 1937 and 1971, and as host of the television program The Red Skelton Show. Skelton, who has stars on the Hollywood Walk of Fame for his work in radio and television, also appeared in vaudeville, films, nightclubs, and casinos, all while he pursued an entirely separate career as an artist.

He was raised a Master Mason in Vincennes Lodge No. 1 on September 20, 1939. He held membership in both the Scottish and York Rite Bodies. He was the recipient of the General Grand Chapter's Gold Medal for Distinguished Service in the Arts and Sciences.

On September 24, 1969, he was coroneted an Inspector General Honorary Thirty-third Degree in Boston, Massachusetts, by the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction of the Scottish Rite. Also, he was a
