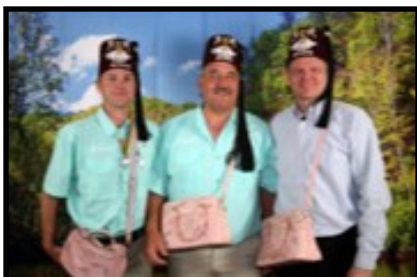

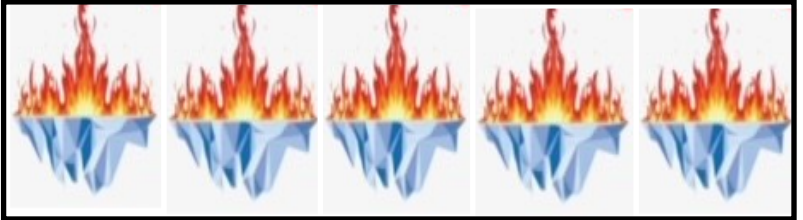

Shriners Childrens Twin Cities Clinic
Board of Governors Report, November 2023

Greetings from the Shriners Childrens Twin Cities Clinic!

I am proud to announce that we have filled two key administrative positions. Melissa Forrest has been hired as Clinic Director. She comes with 20+ years of pediatric healthcare leadership. She is familiar with the Twin Cities Clinic, as she has been employed there for the past two years. Mindy Sewald has been hired as Clinic Manager. She has 15+ years of healthcare experience and will be responsible for clinic operations and provider services. She also has been employed by the Twin Cities Clinic for the past two years. Both of these ladies have proven they can meet the challenge that comes with their positions and will do a great job moving the Twin Cities Clinic forward.

The \$6 million 2024 Operating Budget has been approved by the Twin Cities Board and now goes to Tampa for review and subsequent approval in November. This is \$927,000 less than the 2023 budget. We collaborated with St. Louis, Chicago, and Dayton (Midwest Market) in sharing positions to reduce salaries by \$233,000. We hired surgeons to replace previously contracted surgeons reducing salaries by \$357,000. Also, part of the Midwest Market Strategic Plan was to transition donor development to a centralized location. Twin Cities Clinic is the first facility to test this new process, resulting in a \$377,000 savings.

We planned for 4500 outpatient encounters in our 2023 budget. We have already exceeded that number and expect an additional 700 before the end of the year. The only downside of is that our new patient referrals for the year is projected to be down by 63. To do our part, in November we hope to have two screening clinics in Devils Lake and Minot. As Kem Shriners, we need to do our part to find patients to send to a screening clinic. We should be contacting school nurses, public health districts, chiropractors, clergy, teachers, and other organizations to inform them of the services we provide so they can send kiddos who may need assistance to one of our clinics for evaluation.

The KEM Kids Christmas Party is scheduled for December 2. Invitations will be sent out, but as Shriners we can assist the party committee by reaching out to patients you are aware of in your area and reminding them to attend. Tor and his elves would enjoy seeing 50-60 kids and their families participate!

If you are not aware, Shriners Childrens services assist in helping our patients transition to adulthood beginning at age 12. We assist the patient and families finding providers who are willing to affiliate with us to continue to provide our mental, physical, and social care plan. Imagine what this all entails. I will leave this up to you to ponder.

In closing, thank you for allowing me to be your Shriners Childrens Twin Cities Clinic representative.

The ladies are treated as royalty while the Shriners serve us Mimosas and Brunch while dressed in tuxedos. All proceeds go to the Shriners Children's Hospital!

During this event there are speaker presentations. It's difficult to hold the tears back while listening to the struggles these children go through. But wow, what an inspiration to hear the hope that the Shriners Hospital has given so many kids and their families! 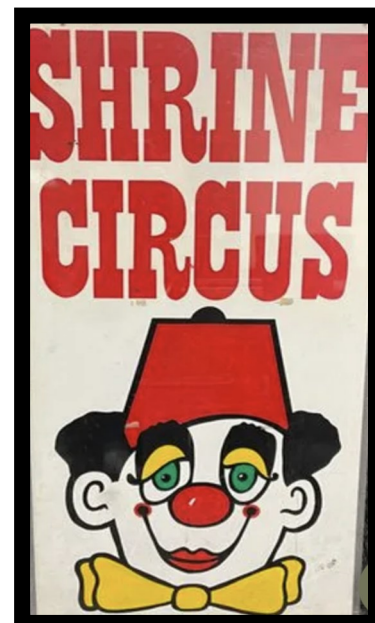

The Shrine Circus is another major fundraising event which provides funding for the hospitals to provide care for children in need. The Shrine Circus was founded in Detroit, Michigan on Woodward Avenue in 1906. It travels to roughly 120 cities per year in the United States and a separate unit travel to about 40 in Canada. It is affiliated with the former Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine, now Shriners International.

Things I'm Super Good At

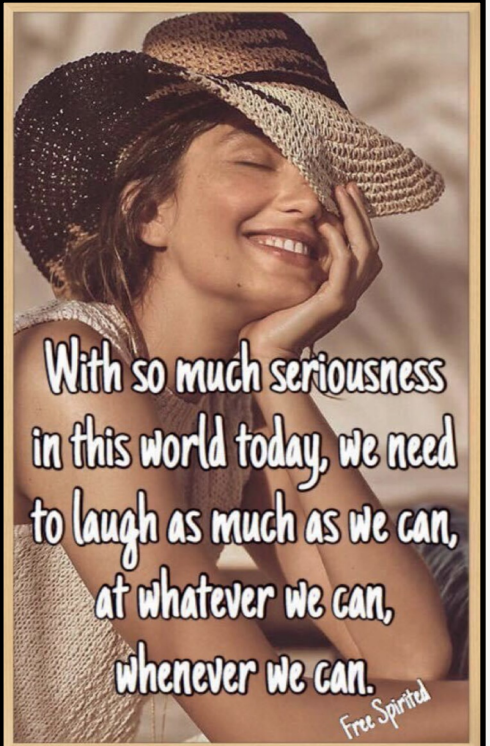
1. Forgetting someone's name 10 seconds after they tell me.
