2025 BOG Annual Meeting Report 1-6-25

Greetings from Shriners Childrens Twin Cities.

If you attended the KEM Annual Meeting, this will be "old" news. Please enjoy reading about one of the best clinics in the Shrine Health System.

We continue to show improvement in our patient statistics. For the year 2024, clinic visits were 4,256 compared to 3,944 in 2023. We had 758 new patients, which is 234 more than 2023. Surgeries were about even at 177. Telehealth services continue to amaze, as we are at 88, but we only budgeted 50 for the year. Telehealth is used in POPS, rehab, outreach clinics, and nutrition services. We expect we will continue to increase in usage to save windshield time for families. 56% of the new patients referred come from healthcare professionals, but only 6% of referrals come from Shriners. We as Shriners need to step up to the plate and increase our total referrals to our goal of 10% for 2025. As a whole, ND had 36 new patients in 2024, which was 5th out of 8 states in our area.

Donations for the Twin Cities continue to roll in, and we met our goal of \$3.5 million.

We have two new programs that were of interest in 2024. The first program being investigated and subsequently started was a joint partnership with Strider Bikes, Rapid City, SD, to complement our adaptive bike program. The Strider Bikes will assist our kiddos with like disabilities to give them a right of passage to feel like everyone else. The bikes assist with improving endurance, balance, and new freedoms. If you want to know more about Strider Bikes in ND, your school districts received state grant monies to pursue Strider Bike programs for kinder kids. The cost of a Strider Bike ranges from \$250-\$500. Adaptive bikes with specialty features range from \$1600 to \$2800. Detailed information about these amazing bikes can be found at the Strider website: www.StriderBikes.com

Our second program is a Genomics study, started in late October. This program is to determine potential disorders through DNA. So far we have had 10 families enrolled, which is the most of any Midwest Market facilities. We hope to see an increased enrollment in this study.

Screening Clinics seem to be picking up, as Bruce Krabseth has completed 3 this year. Randy Shear (GF) and Chris Boushey (Crookston) will be working with Bruce on screening clinics in 2025. Please reach out to them to offer your help with marketing these important clinics, especially in NW Minnesota. Some of you have asked about the various camps, like Achieve and Bravo. These continue to be popular, as this year we had 388 participants in our camps at a cost of \$103 per camper. This does not include the 1-day events, such as the Halloween Bash and Breakfast with Santa. As a side note, Breakfast with Santa had 304 patients and family members in attendance. Afton Alps skiing day continues to be popular also, with 71 kids and volunteers participating.

As for me, I recently completed terms on the Executive Committee, Transportation Policy Committee, and Chairman of the Finance Committee. For 2025-26 I will be on the Marketing and Human Resources Committees. If you have any questions about these committees, please reach out to me.

Thank you for letting me serve as your Board rep. We are looking forward to having a great 2025!
